A Note From Pastor Bill

Every time I visited Aunt Ruth (Truman) and her husband Dick in their Bayshore Estates home they talked about Wrightsville UMC-about how blessed they were to be part of the church family. Aunt Ruth would speak of her time with Mothers' Morning Out, the joy she felt being with the children and the other adults who helped with that program. She spoke of the vibrancy of morning worship, of the love of the congregation, and she talked about how much P.D.'s visits meant to her. "It is a very special place, a wonderful community," she would say again and again.

Aunt Ruth was right. When Bob Bauman called three years ago and invited me to join the ministerial team here, my aunt's love and appreciation for this congregation and its staff caused me to quickly say yes. I will miss being an integral part of it, but I am confident in the decision I have prayerfully made to retire (again) at the end of March.

Relatively healthy at 71 and still with boundless energy (most of the time), I want and need to move on to the next stage of my life—to whatever it is that the Lord has for me.

Really, I would like to experience the freedom of true retirement—going on a family trip to Italy with no worries about leaving my work for someone else to do, helping AnaAustin get settled wherever graduate school takes her (and going to visit whenever the notion strikes—especially if she settles in New York), spending weeks at Lake Junaluska on the porch or walking Parkway trails, being "hands-on" with Patricia in the garden as it begins to come to life again, seeking opportunities for volunteerism where I can pursue my passion for social justice.

I thank you for loving and embracing me--for listening to my sermons, for attending my Bible studies, for gladly accepting my visits, for laughing at the crazy things I have said and done in morning announcements, for commenting on my enthusiasm for doing what God has called me to do, even for noticing how I tap my feet and sway to the inspiring music of Sunday mornings. Thank you for praying for me. You have been supportive, accepting and affirming.

Saying goodbye is not easy, and it is particularly difficult when the people to whom you bid farewell have shown such love. You have-again and again. You have touched my life and given me worth. I will always be grateful.

Walk the Labyrinth During Holy Week

This Holy Week (Mar. 26-30), connect with God in a unique way by walking the prayer labyrinth we will be hosting in the Fellowship Hall. You can take as much or little time as you want, but you may want to allow at least 15-30 minutes.

Centuries of Christians have "walked their prayers" through making a pilgrimage to a holy site or walking a labyrinth. The labyrinth represents our Christian life—a journey to the heart of God. The labyrinth is not a maze. It has only one entrance and one exit, with no tricks or dead ends. No matter how winding the path, you can trust that God is guiding your steps and will not let you get lost.

- Remove your shoes and pause at the entrance, praying that God will lead you in your prayer.
- Walk slowly, breathing deeply, and imagine that you are traveling to the center of your soul, where the Holy Spirit speaks to you. As you walk to the center, you may want to bring to God your cares and concerns, a particular question that you need wisdom about, or something you want to let go of.
- When you reach the center, rest for a few moments to have a leisurely conversation with God. Or simply rest in God's presence.
- Follow the path back out again, letting go of those things that burden you or stand in the way of loving God and others.

WUMC and the Help Hub

For years, area churches and non-profits have discussed ways to more efficiently serve those in financial need and/or to help connect them to other resources. As a result, the Harrelson Center and three area churches combined to form The Help Hub in 2015. In 2016 WUMC joined as members of the Help Hub and are now one of 10 area churches who have combined resources to help those in need. The Help Hub has tremendously relieved the burden of church staff members and offers a central "clearing house" for those seeking assistance.

The Help Hub is open Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday from 9:00-12:00. Individuals and families seeking emergency assistance are met by a greeter who helps them in fill out the required intake form and helps to make the client feel more comfortable while waiting to see their advisor. The advisor, who is also a volunteer, will then carefully assess each person's situation and determine how the Help Hub can financially help and/or direct them to other resources in the Harrelson Center. After assistance is given, the data entry person documents each client and how they were helped.

The Mission of The Help Hub is to assist and direct people in a time of crisis. When individuals are scared and unsure of how to deal with a difficult situation, the Help Hub is a place that cares. Along with monetary assistance, The Help Hub delivers compassion, hope and love that is greatly appreciated by the clients. This is what we are a part of. 
