

### Deep Roots... Bountiful Fruit... It Happens Here

The headline above is the slogan of Wrightsville United Methodist Church. It is on the cover of the Sunday morning bulletin each week. It is also inside the bulletin on the schedule for the week. When the church sends out a letter, you will find the slogan on the bottom of the page. And as you walk down the first floor hallway by the church offices, you will see two bulletin boards. One is called the "Deep Roots" board. And the other shows "Bountiful Fruit." Furthermore, our logo shows a person in the shape of a tree that is bearing fruit for the kingdom of God.

Our slogan is guided by two Bible verses. One is John 15:5, which reads, "I am the vine and you are the branches. Those who abide in me and I in them bear much fruit, because apart from me you can do nothing." The other is Galatians 5:22-23, which lists the fruit of the Spirit. It reads like this, "By contrast, the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. There is no law against such things."

We will be starting a new sermon series in September which will explore our slogan. How can we grow deeper roots? And how can we produce more bountiful fruit? How do we stay connected to the vine? And what if I try and try but simply cannot bear as much fruit as other people that I know, or as much as I used to?

We will be talking about these topics in worship, but we will also be giving you opportunities to plant deeper roots and produce bountiful fruit. Keep your eyes and ears open to the bulletin, e-blast, newsletter, social media, and bulletin boards as we continue to emphasize the slogan of our church throughout the month of September.

We've received requests to sponsor a program concerning the how, what, where, and whys concerning our end of life emotional and legal arrangements.

We will have a presentation open to all on Wednesday, September 18, 2019 at 6:30 pm in the Fellowship Hall. The program will be approximately 90 minutes in length and will include information from community resources as well as Wrightsville UMC pastoral staff.

Jason Clamme of Lower Cape Fear Hospice will discuss making decisions in writing about our desires as to how and when we physically end our earthly home. It covers when to resuscitate, what palliative measures have been decided on, and information for those friends and family who love us. The Five Wishes booklet is a good resource for this purpose, and we will have it available on that day. It is legal in NC with a notary seal and witness.

Jennifer Marshall Roden, Attorney and Counselor at Law, will discuss the alternatives and requirements for a full will document, an overview of estate planning, and other items that should be addressed.

Finally, Pastor Hope will review the Wrightsville UMC document that includes family member contacts, what type of service you request, music, and officiators among any other wishes you choose. These are kept on file at the church.

We kindly ask that you sign up on the deep roots bulletin board with the number who will be attending so that we can provide enough handouts and forms for all of those in attendance.

Jim received dual masters degrees in Substance Abuse and Clinical Counseling and Rehabilitation Counseling from East Carolina University. He is a Licensed Professional Counselor and Licensed Clinical Addictions Specialist and has a profound respect for human suffering. Jim is especially interested in helping people find recovery from a variety of life stresses and events, addiction, mental health, and exploring family of origin dynamics.

A Safe Place focuses on prevention, advocacy, and restoration to assist victims of commercial sexual exploitation and domestic sex trafficking.

13<sup>th</sup> Street House for Women helps women to transition from jail, prison, and treatment centers back into the community and empowers them to become self-sufficient by assisting with employment opportunities and reconnecting with families.

The Tides provides a comprehensive, intensive outpatient treatment and recovery program for women with Opioid Use Disorder who are pregnant or post-delivery. Its goal is to keep mother and child together as they receive the care they need for recovery.
