# Why I Give

The tooth fairy pays much better than she did when I was a kid. In the '80s and '90s, when I lost a front tooth eating an apple, I woke up the next morning to a crisp dollar bill or fifty cents under my pillow. About that time, my mom taught me how to give to the church. You set aside 10%, which was called a tithe, she said. For a dollar, I would set aside a dime. If it was fifty cents, a nickel. If I made \$5 from hawking my old Barbies at our yard sale? Two shiny quarters.

As a kid, I accepted that this was a thing you just did – like brushing your teeth or hair before going to school. But as I went to college and began trying to pay my own bills, I wondered – why give, really? Couldn't my local church make it on the gifts of a couple of people better off than me? Would my couple hundred bucks really make a difference?

Jesus talked a lot about money – more than he talked about almost any other subject. In fact, in Matthew 6:21, he said, "For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also." By giving, God does a couple of things all at once. (God is smart like that.) When I give, God shapes my heart to care about the things that God cares about the most. God increases my faith that God will provide for what I need. And God uses my gifts as part of the giving of Wrightsville UMC to do much greater things than they could do on their own. God knits me together with you.

Our October practice for Vision 2020 is to increase giving. October is the season when we develop our yearly church budgets. Each year, our church staff, lay leaders, and Finance Committee prayerfully evaluate what money we have spent that year and seek to come up with a faith-based budget for the year ahead. God has always come through for us through the generosity of the congregation. Even in a pandemic, when finances are tight, we are grateful to God for the ways our church family has continued to give.

As a pastor, I have the gift of being able to see some of the ways God uses our gifts *together*. Together, our gifts continue to help our youth and children grow in faith, whether online or outdoors! We will finally confirm the Confirmation Class of 2020 and begin Confirmation for the Class of 2021. We hope to begin outdoor worship for morning worship and Sundays at Six. We will begin new studies and provide fellowship for our seniors. We will hold our first Virtual Son Run to raise money for three organizations. (That's just in October!)

Maybe giving on a regular basis as a spiritual practice is familiar to you. Or maybe it's new. Maybe you have been giving ten percent of your income or more for a long time – or maybe that seems unattainable right now. This month, can you prayerfully increase your giving in some way? Pray and choose an amount together with God. Talk to your spouse, family, friend, or parent. (And maybe give some kids in your life an important math lesson – how to give a couple of shiny quarters.)

### Message From Pastor Hope To Our Seniors

I wanted to let you know about a gathering as the church starts some small openings this fall. In October on Wednesday mornings from 11 am to noon, I am going to meet with any senior adults who would like to gather outside in the covered parking area under the Fellowship Hall. We will have to be very careful about safety rules, but seeing each other for just a little while outside would lift so many spirits.

The safety rules of wearing a mask, use hand sanitizer, stay 6 feet apart, bring your own chair and stay outside will be followed. No food or drinks. I realize not everyone will want to come, but for those who do, we can have a prayer and a little visit. I am hoping to pass this by word of mouth and thank you if you can help pass the news. I hope you are doing well!



# Safety Protocols for Small Group Meetings (Phase 2.5)\*

Out of love for our neighbors, intent to do no harm, and desire to spread the Word of God and not COVID-19, The Wrightsville United Methodist Church Re-Entry Committee has developed the following safety rules for return to on-site gatherings.

- The added intensive cleaning schedule requires that meeting attendees not go into other spaces/areas before or after scheduled meetings and to use the restroom closest to meeting space. Everyone should leave the building within 15 minutes from the end of meeting.
- Face coverings are to be worn inside and outside the building. Disposable masks will be provided.
- No eating or drinking inside or outside the building.
- Practice social distancing (six foot distance between individuals).
- Temperature checks for all participants.
- Please stay home if anyone in your family is not feeling well or experiencing any symptoms (including fever, chills, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, cough, or loss of taste or smell). Please follow state and local guidelines on self-quarantine if your family travels.
- Please inform the group leader if you or your child develops symptoms of the virus after attending a class/ event/meeting OR tests positive for the virus OR comes into contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 (especially family members).
- These protocols are for the safety of all participants. If you are not comfortable with the rules set forth at this time, we ask that you wait until restrictions have been relaxed before you attend any small groups taking place on-site at Wrightsville UMC.

\*These rules are subject to change as the state moves to different phases and at the discretion of Wrightsville United Methodist Church Re-Entry Committee (composed of representatives from Administrative Council, Trustees, Staff Parish, medical professionals from within the congregation and WUMC Staff).



The 22<sup>nd</sup> annual Son Run/Walk, sponsored by the Outreach Committee, will go on, despite COVID-19. BUT, it will be held virtually in 2020. This event has been part of the fall calendar at WUMC for 21 years and You Can't Stop Us!!! The run/walk has provided significant amounts of money in the past 21 years to agencies that help our neighbors in need. The majority of funds raised in previous years were graciously donated by local businesses. After thoughtful consideration, this year the Outreach Committee decided not to approach local businesses for donations in light of the economic losses to the business community due to COVID-19.

- WHO: Ladies and gentlemen and children of all ages!!!
- WHERE: You choose where to run/walk.
- WHEN: During the period October 10-18. You will run/walk as often as you wish during the 9 day period. You will record the distances you accumulate and will post it on the WUMC website at www.wrightsvilleumc.org. We hope you will send photos to wumcsonrun2020@gmail.com as you participate.



Welcome to Wrightsville UMC's Confirmation Class of 2020-2021! We are excited that your youth will be taking this journey with us.
