**IMPORTANT NOTE: NO SCHOOL TUESDAY, MAY 3rd.** If you refer to your yearlong calendar, you will see that May 3rd has always been a scheduled day off. The schedule was written last summer, as we were following the Public School calendar. The original Public School Calendar was revised in October to accommodate Public Schools being out the day of the Primaries, Mar. 15th, instead of a day off on May 3rd. We continued with our calendar and went ahead and held classes on March 15th, even though they didn't. Since we did not budget for school on May 3rd, we will stick with our calendar and have no school that day. It costs approximately \$500 a day to operate our program, so you can see how it would have a big impact! Thank you for your understanding.

### **Teacher Workday and Optional Parent/Teacher Conferences**

Spring Parent/Teacher Conference Day will be held on Friday, May 13th. Many of you already know your plans for the upcoming fall, so **we are making these conferences optional unless your child's teacher specifically asks you to schedule a time.** We love all of our preschoolers and will be happy to meet with any and all families to discuss the progress we have seen over the school year!

### **Beach Day- Tuesday, May 17th!**

Don't forget! Beach Day will be held on Tuesday, May 17<sup>th</sup> from 9:15-12:15. We will gather one mile north of Johnnie Mercer's Pier (on the south side of Duneridge Condominiums-L shaped parking lot). Public parking, bathrooms and beach access are available at this location. Please remember to bring money or debit card for parking. Snacks and drinks will be provided by the preschool. **We need to know who will be providing adult supervision for your child so please be sure you have turned in your form by Thursday, May 12<sup>th</sup> (extra forms are available on the bulletin board).** With proper supervision, siblings are welcome. Remember to bring plenty of sunscreen! In the event of rain, we will meet at the preschool for a regular school day.

### **Year End Celebration Program and Covered Dish Luncheon:**

Tuesday, May 24th, will be our last day of school. An exciting day is planned. Our preschoolers will provide entertainment during an informal program in the Sanctuary at 11:00 am. They will share some of their favorite songs which they have learned throughout the year. This will be followed by a covered dish luncheon in the Fellowship Hall.

Teachers will post signup sheets for food. You will find these on top of the cubbies later this week. Please be sure to list the number of people from your family who are expecting to attend. We hope everyone will be able to come to this very special event! Grandparents are welcome too! If you sign up for the ham and turkey platter or the chicken nuggets you will be making a donation towards the cost of the platters and that money will be due no later than Thursday, May 19<sup>th</sup>. We will have committee or parent volunteers scheduled to pick these up. If you plan to have more than 4 people from your family attending our luncheon, please consider bringing an extra side dish so that there will be plenty for everyone.

## Parental Involvement

To parents of children entering kindergarten, we encourage you to be active volunteers in your child's school. Room parents, field trip volunteers, tutors, PTA committee members, etc. are always needed. Your child will be thrilled that you are participating and it is a great way for you to get a really good picture of what is going on in your child's school.

## 2016-2017 Enrollment Packets and Start Up Dates

Children and parents attending W.U.M. Preschool in the Fall will be invited to an Open House on Tuesday, Sept 6th and our first full day of classes will be on Wednesday, Sept. 7th for our Four and Five Year Old Classes and on Thursday, Sept. 8th for our Three Year Old Classes. In early July, you will receive an Enrollment Packet in the mail. To continue to guarantee your child's placement for next year, the forms in the packet along with a \$50 supply fee will need to be returned NO LATER THAN Friday, JULY 29<sup>th</sup>. **Don't forget to include an updated copy of your child's shot record.** If your address has changed or you will be out of town when packets are due, please let me know. **If your plans for the upcoming school year change, please be sure to contact me as soon as possible. I would greatly appreciate it! It is important that we stay fully enrolled. This keeps costs down for everyone.**
