What's Going on With the United Methodist Church?

A lot of people have been asking me lately "Why are some churches leaving the United Methodist Church?" Obviously, I couldn't begin to answer that question for every church individually; but I think I can safely say why it is happening in general.

There is a fear that the United Methodist Church (UMC) is going to change its stance on human sexuality. There has been no change to the Book of Discipline since 2019 because General Conference has been postponed several times due to the worldwide Covid-19 pandemic. But many people believe that the rules around same-sex marriage and ordination may change soon. AND/OR... When pastors have broken the rules currently laid out in the Book of Discipline and performed same-sex weddings, some people believe the penalties against these pastors have not been strong enough.

Therefore, some churches have decided to leave. Most of these departing churches have decided to form a new denomination called the Global Methodist Church, while some others have decided to simply go independent and not be a part of any denomination.

Why is this happening now? For one, tension has been increasing around this issue for many years. Secondly, the postponement of the 2020 General Conference to 2024 has left some churches feeling uncertain about the denomination's stance on same-sex marriage and LGBTQ+ people's ordinations in the future. They wanted to be in a place where these issues were settled and where there would be more accountability for those who broke the rules.

The United Methodist Church is known for its "methods." We have rules and structures in place that connect us as a denomination. And we have rules for churches who want to leave, as well. If a church decides that it wants to leave the UMC it must pay two years' worth of apportionments plus a dollar amount that will assist with the pension liability for the pastors who have faithfully served the church in the past. At Wrightsville, we can expect the sum of the apportionments plus the pension liability to be somewhere between \$750,000 and \$1,000,000. Then, the Administrative Council would have to authorize a vote of the whole church to decide on whether they want to disaffiliate. If that passes, then there would be a church conference allowing every member to vote. It takes a two-third's majority of all the voting members who are present at the conference to agree to disaffiliate for the motion to pass. Finally, the annual conference has to agree that the church can disaffiliate by a simple majority vote. We will actually be having a special called Annual Conference on November 19th to allow several dozen churches from Eastern North Carolina to leave the denomination.

So, that's the big news happening around the denomination and around the North Carolina Annual Conference. It'll be really weird not being in the same denomination as many of my friends and family members after being in the same denomination for years. I know that some of you share the same concerns as those in the churches who are seeking to leave the UMC. But, I hope we can all stay together here at Wrightsville, even if we don't all agree on every theological point. We need liberals, moderates, and conservatives; progressives, centrists, and traditionalists. There is a place for all of us.

I am not convinced that leaving the United Methodist Church would make us a stronger church. I certainly don't want to raise hundreds of thousands of dollars to leave when such money could go toward helping the mission and ministry of our congregation and the community that we serve. Our church is on a very positive trajectory right now as we move away from the restrictions caused by the Covid pandemic, and I foresee us staying on this path.

Furthermore, we have enjoyed a very healthy historical relationship with our conference and denomination. Long before you received your current appointed pastors this church received a series of outstanding ministers that have led Wrightsville faithfully for 75 years. If a church leaves the UMC, where will their next pastor come from? To what rules and order will they be held accountable? While certainly no one is perfect, the practice of receiving a pastor from the Bishop and Cabinet within the UMC means that your next pastor will have been evaluated before being sent here and that they will be held accountable to a set of rules and a group of people larger than him or herself.

And the connection to our United Methodist denomination allows us to do more and better ministry. The reason we are assisting with a hospital for women and children in Sierra Leone is because of the United Methodist Church in Sierra Leone. The hospital was re-built and staffed by the United Methodist Church. The primary international partners have been Wrightsville UMC, the North Carolina Conference, and the United Methodist Church in Norway. Methodists in Northern Europe, North Carolina, and West Africa are all making a difference together. And there are literally thousands of partnerships like that taking place all over the world and right in our own backyard. The Methodist Home for Children is such a partnership. So is Camp Don Lee. UMCOR for disaster ministries. Even Duke University and the Divinity School, as well as High Point University, Louisburg College, and North Carolina Wesleyan were all started by and continue to receive support from the United Methodist Church.

I lament that some churches feel they need to leave the denomination at this time. I hope they will be successful and faithful in their future ministry endeavors. But I see a bright future for the United Methodist Church, and especially for Wrightsville United Methodist. We will continue to share the Good News with a broken world and make disciples of Jesus Christ, just like we've been doing for the past 75 years.
