#### **Goodbye For Now**

As I prepare to leave Wrightsville, I keep thinking of the words usually attributed to A.A Mine: "How lucky I am to have something that makes saying goodbye so hard."

Four years ago, as I was finishing my last semester of seminary and waiting to find out where I would be appointed as a pastor, I prayed to be sent to a vital and vibrant church. From the moment I first stepped on our campus, I knew God had answered my prayer. But I never dreamt of the incredible experiences I would have at Wrightsville.

During my four years at Wrightsville, I have baptized more babies than many United Methodist pastors will throughout their entire ministry. I've taught two classes of confirmands and been blessed by their questions. I've looked out on your faces, shining in candlelight, on Christmas Eve as we sing Silent Night. I had the opportunity to help realize the dream of an extension campus, Wrightsville on Oleander, which was born from the resurrection faith of Oleander UMC. I've seen kids take on worship leadership roles as acolytes and lay readers, and wondered which of them might grow up to be pastors one day. I've been blown away by your generosity in time, finances, and donations as we seek to serve our community. I've led Bible Studies and watched participants' eyes light up when they realize something new about God. I've baptized new believers in the ocean. I've blessed dogs, cats, guinea pigs, bunnies, lizards, butterflies, and iguanas. I've visited you in the hospital, met your newborn babies, and even buried your loved ones in the hope of the resurrection.

Although I have always done the best I could, I know I have surely made mistakes. Thank you for the grace you have extended to me when I have been wrong. Thank you for letting me try new things and take risks. As I prepare to launch a new church in Leland, I will carry everything you taught me with me. Wrightsville, thank you for being the church that made me a pastor. I am more grateful for you than I could ever put into words.

I want to leave you with the words of the benediction I share every time I preach, which I learned from my home church in Ohio. Many of you have asked me for the text, and now you will all have it! Receive this blessing:

"May the Spirit of the Living God, made known to us most fully in Jesus Christ our Lord,

Go before you to show you the way

Go behind you to push you into places you might not go on your own

Go above you to watch over you and protect you

Go beneath you to lift you up when you cannot stand

Go beside you to be your companion

And dwell within you to remind you every day that you are not alone, and that you are loved beyond your wildest imagination."

Finally, we are home!



We haven't met our budget goal and want to encourage those that are interested to make their Memorial Garden reservation by this Sunday, June 1. Our introductory prices expire on June 1, 2025. We need to collect the funds to cover the cost of the Memorial Garden construction and are eager to get started.

Do you want your niche to be next to another family member's niche in the Garden? Make your reservations now so that y'all can "pick your neighborhood"! When you reserve a niche, you choose which niche you want.

Do you have your loved one's cremains stored at home and have wondered what to do with them? If your loved one was a member of our church, you can reserve a niche for him or her or make a reservation to bury the ashes in the Garden. If your loved one was not a member of the church or is already buried or interred elsewhere, you can still memorialize them and include their name on the Memorial Plaque that will be included in the Garden.

If you already have other plans for your remains when you die but you have strong connections right here at Wrightsville UMC, you can make a reservation for yourself to have your name placed on the church's Memorial Plaque at your death. Let us know at the time of the reservation and we can save room for more than one person's name to be by each other on the Memorial Plaque.

You can choose to have your name on the Memorial Plaque next to other family members if you make reservations for all family members at one time. We can also do the same for family members that make reservations for their cremains to be buried in the garden. There will be a separate Plaque for those whose cremains are buried in the garden.

The Memorial Garden Committee will be making reservations in front of the Fellowship Hall this Sunday, June 1, from 8:00 am. to 12:00 pm. This will be the last opportunity to get the introductory price for reservations. Help us reach our goal so that we can begin construction this summer!
