### Sign Up to Volunteer

1. First time volunteers need to complete the [volunteer waiver](#) prior to arriving at the warehouse. Returning volunteers do not need to fill out the waiver again. If you volunteer at multiple sessions this summer, you only need to complete the waiver once. Parents/guardians can complete one waiver for both themselves and their children.
2. In order to participate as a volunteer, you must reserve a volunteer spot using the links below. Each link is specific to each session. You must reserve a spot for yourself and any children over the age of 6 who will be helping. Each session is capped at 16 participants.

### What to Expect

**Location** -- Our warehouse is located at 915 South 16th Street. When coming down 16th, the entrance to our gravel parking lot is the first driveway on the left after the old pharmacy on the corner of Dawson/16th. Our building is a beige colored warehouse. Since we do not do direct distribution at this facility, we don't have any signage identifying the space as ours. If you have any trouble finding us, call 910-777-3243. **\*\*Please be advised, GPS isn't always accurate finding our warehouse.\*\***

**Parking** -- Our parking lot is on the small side. *Carpooling is encouraged!* If the parking lot is full when you arrive, please continue past our lot and turn left on Wright St. where you can park on the street. DO NOT park in the eye doctor's office or the empty pharmacy on either side of our facility.

**What will you do?** -- Volunteers repackage diapers or period products, prepare orders for our community partner agencies who distribute our basic need items, and organize donations. Work is done standing, but accommodations can be made for those who would like to sit.

**What should you wear?** -- Our warehouse is climate controlled, but please wear attire that is comfortable for movement and working. For safety reasons, we do require all participants to wear closed-toed shoes.

**Are children welcome?** -- Yes, we love little helpers! Young children are welcome to help with a variety of tasks under the supervision of their parent/guardian. Our youngest friends who may not have the attention span to help are welcome to enjoy our play room full of toys, books, and games. Our restroom is equipped with a changing table and diaper genie for your convenience.

**Can you donate when you come?** -- Yes! Diaper need is at an all-time high and we are having difficulty keeping several items in stock. Donations focused on these items would be most appreciated: size 7 diapers, toddler pullups, baby wipes, and disposable adult incontinence underwear in larger sizes (i.e., Depends).
