As our nation approaches its 250th birthday on July 4, 2026, we have an opportunity to pause and give thanks. Two hundred and fifty years is a remarkable milestone. As fireworks light the sky this July, may they remind us not only of the birth of a nation but also of the enduring light of Christ. Long after every earthly kingdom has passed away, His kingdom will remain.

So let us celebrate with grateful hearts. Let us pray for our nation and its leaders. Let us work for justice, peace, and compassion in our communities. And above all, let us remember that the Church's calling is not to lift high any earthly banner, but to lift high the name of Jesus Christ, the King of kings and Lord of lords.

Happy 250th birthday, America. And thanks be to God for the kingdom that will never end.

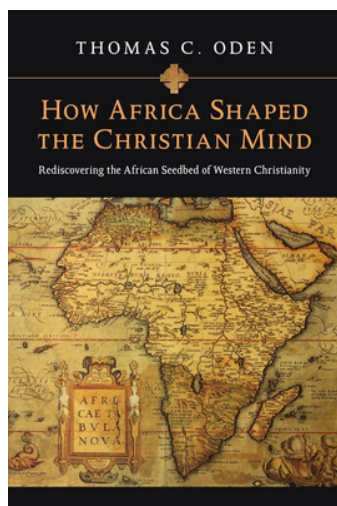

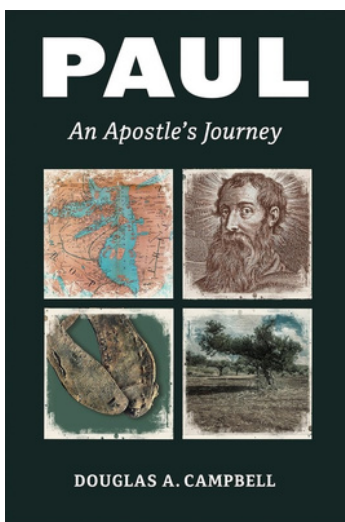
Pastor Miles' July Book Recommendations

The life of faith involves both devotion and understanding. Through study and reflection, our minds and hearts are gently shaped and deepened in the way of Christ. Here are a few book recommendations for July to encourage thoughtful reading and continued growth in faith.



How Africa Shaped the Christian Mind by Thomas C. Oden

What if some of Christianity's most important intellectual and spiritual foundations were laid not in Europe, but in Africa? In ***How Africa Shaped the Christian Mind***, theologian Thomas C. Oden challenges common assumptions about the history of the Church, arguing that many of the developments that shaped Christian doctrine, biblical interpretation, monasticism, and theological education emerged first in North Africa. Oden not only recovers this often-overlooked history but also invites Christians to rethink the story of their faith and rediscover the rich legacy of African Christianity. Whether you are interested in church history, theology, or the global nature of the Christian faith, this book offers a compelling and illuminating perspective.



Paul: An Apostle's Journey by Douglas A. Campbell

Who was Paul, and how did a former persecutor of the Church become one of its most influential apostles? In ***Paul: An Apostle's Journey***, New Testament scholar Douglas Campbell introduces readers to the life, travels, and theological vision of the apostle whose letters continue to shape Christian faith and practice. Rather than treating Paul's ideas as abstract doctrines, Campbell situates them within the dramatic story of his ministry, revealing how his encounters, challenges, and missionary work informed his understanding of the gospel. Accessible without being simplistic, this book offers a compelling portrait of Paul as both a thinker and a pastor, making it an excellent resource for anyone seeking a deeper appreciation of the New Testament and the early Christian movement.

The TeachReach program will enter its fourth year at Snipes and Freeman elementary schools next fall, and we need about 25 volunteers who are willing to "adopt" a teacher.

"Adopting" a teacher means providing regular support, about once or twice a month, in the form of cards, flowers, gift cards, snacks, etc. that the teacher prefers. Teachers in these high-poverty schools are typically inexperienced and get no support otherwise from the community. Our experience has been that this support from someone they didn't previously know means more to these teachers than they can express.

Teachers are surveyed by the school district every other year on workplace conditions. One of the questions has to do with whether community member support contributes to the success of the school.

From the 2022 to 2026 surveys, the percentage of teachers who "agree" with that statement at Freeman has increased from 64% to 81%, with "strongly agree" responses doubling. At Snipes, the "agree" rate has increased from 68% to 94%, with "strongly agree" increasing almost 150%.
