Annual Conference Season

If you've been around the church for a while, you may have heard the term "Annual Conference." If not, or if you just need a refresher, I hope this is a helpful introduction. In The United Methodist Church, the term "Annual Conference" can refer to several things. Sometimes it refers to a geographical region. For example, we are part of the North Carolina Annual Conference, which covers the eastern part of North Carolina. Each annual conference is led by a bishop.

At other times, "Annual Conference" refers to the yearly gathering of clergy and church members from across the region. This year, from June 18–20, pastors and lay members from across eastern North Carolina will gather in Greenville for the North Carolina Annual Conference.

One distinctive feature of The United Methodist Church is the important role laity play in the life and leadership of the church. One way this is reflected is through representation at Annual Conference: each United Methodist congregation elects lay members equal to the number of appointed clergy serving that church. Because Wrightsville UMC has three appointed pastors, we elect three lay members to attend the conference alongside the clergy.

You may be wondering what actually takes place at Annual Conference, and the answer is quite a lot! First and foremost, Annual Conference is a time of worship. Together, we pray, sing, celebrate Communion, and engage in what John Wesley called "holy conferencing." Such conferencing is the practice of seeking God's wisdom together through conversation, discernment, and community. Annual Conference also attends to the administrative and organizational work of the church. Members approve the conference budget, receive reports from ministries and committees, act on recommendations, vote on resolutions, recognize retired clergy, and celebrate the ordination and commissioning of new clergy for ministry in the church. Annual Conference is also the occasion at which the bishop officially sets, or "fixes," the appointments of pastors for the following year. In many ways, Annual Conference reflects both the spiritual and practical life of the church as we seek to serve Christ together.

Annual Conference is also a reminder that our local church is part of something much bigger than ourselves, indeed connectional. Churches are meant to work together rather than alone. Through that connection, we support one another in ministry, joining together in mission and service in ways that would be difficult for any single church to do on its own. Annual Conference is one of the clearest expressions of that connection, reminding us we are stronger, wiser, and more faithful when we journey together.

As our pastors and lay members prepare to travel to Greenville this June, I invite you to keep the conference in your prayers. If you have questions about Annual Conference or want to discuss more about the wider church, feel free to reach out!

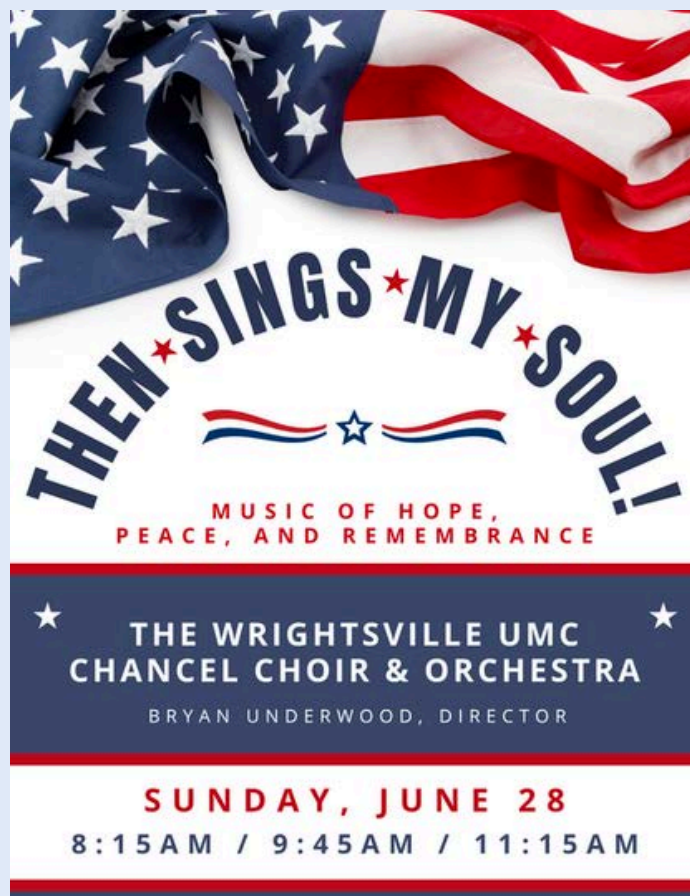

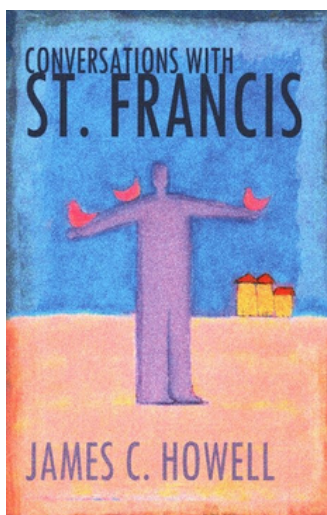

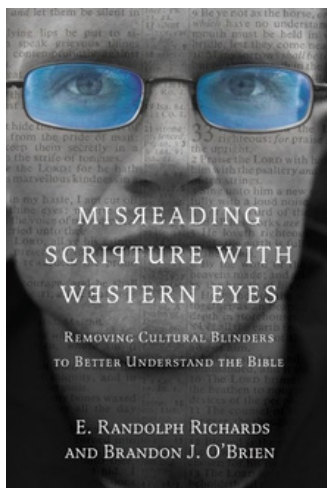
Pastor Miles' June Book Recommendations

The life of faith involves both devotion and understanding. Through study and reflection, our minds and hearts are gently shaped and deepened in the way of Christ. Here are a few book recommendations for June to encourage thoughtful reading and continued growth in faith.



***Conversations with St. Francis* | James C. Howell**

If you were able to talk to St. Francis of Assisi, what would you ask him? “Perhaps,” says James Howell, “the first question I’d want to ask Francis would be something like this: How did you do it? Were you real? How much of your story really happened? And I’m asking because I am wondering how I might do it: could I somehow grab a share of the life you had? The marvel in Francis’s story is that all he did seems entirely doable – but then, at the same time, ridiculously impossible. As I survey the bare facts of his life, it all seems so manageably simple, and yet unquestionably what happened was nothing short of miraculous.” In this spiritually apt look at the life, message, and meaning of St. Francis, Howell invites all of us to pose our most difficult spiritual questions to the saint—and to listen for the questions he asks of us in response.



***Misreading Scripture with Western Eyes: Removing Cultural Blinders to Better Understand the Bible* | E. Randolph Richards & Brandon J. O'Brien**

In this pivotal and landmark text of Methodism, Heitzenrater provides a clear and engaging introduction to the origins and development of the Methodist movement. Following the life and ministry of John Wesley, Heitzenrater traces the rise of the early Methodist societies, their practices of accountability and discipleship, and the theological convictions that shaped their mission. The book explores how Methodism grew within the Church of England, spread through preaching and small groups, and became a movement focused on personal and social holiness. Thoughtful and accessible, this volume is a helpful resource for anyone interested in Methodist history, identity, and the continuing influence of Wesley’s vision in the church today.

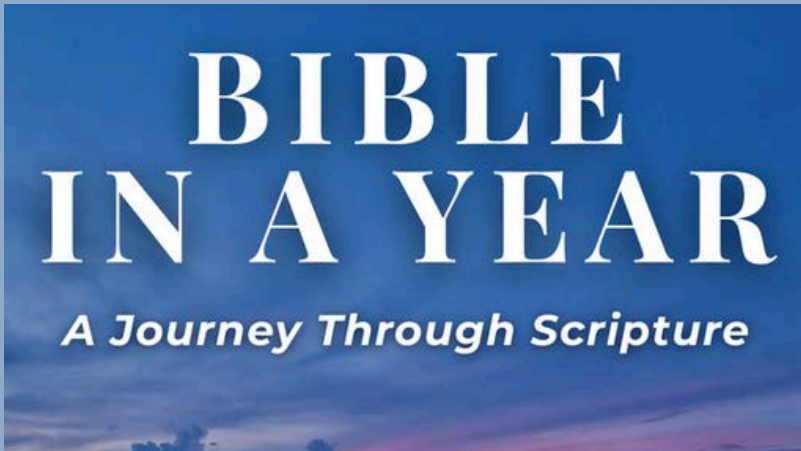

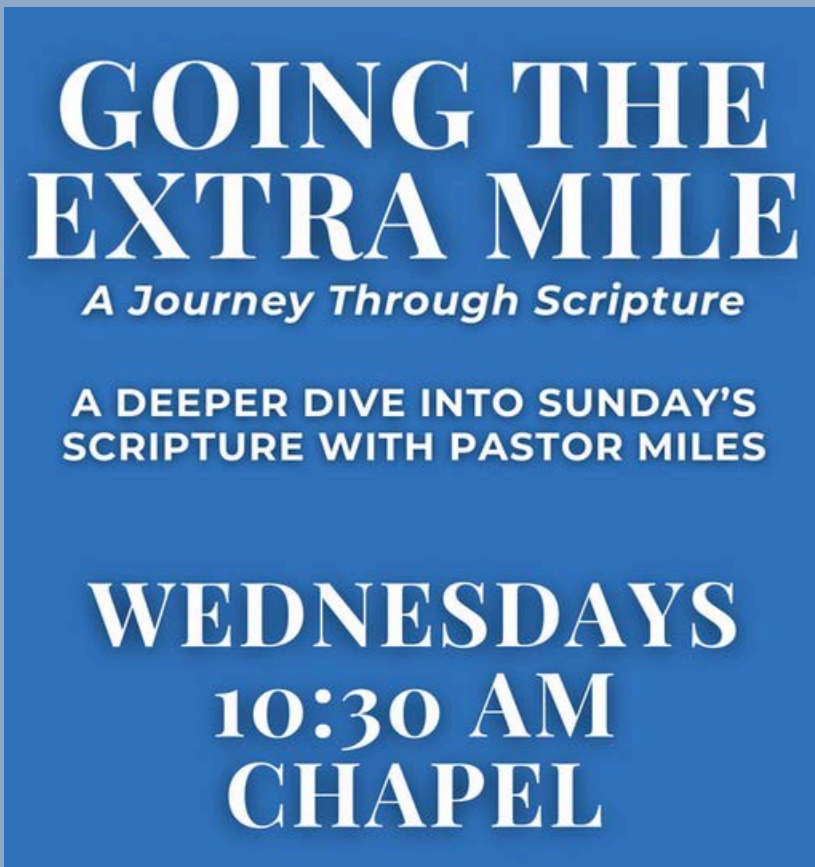

Outreach Opportunities this month!

- **Salvation Army Center of Hope** - Each day, meal servers are needed from 4:45 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. Volunteers will sign in and assist with assembly line-style dinner service for residents at 5 p.m. Then they will fix to-go trays for a community feed at 6 p.m. and possibly assist with handing out those meals. Some light cleaning is needed after the meal service.
- **TeachReach** - We are recruiting volunteers who wish to adopt a teacher next year at either Snipes or Freeman elementary schools. Teachers at these schools receive no community support, so we write them notes and give them small tokens of appreciations throughout the year.


